e.g: NOT: the restaurant that we go to it.

NOT: someone who I work with her.

2. Lược bỏ đại từ quan hệ

Chúng ta thường lược bỏ đại từ quan hệ khi nó làm túc từ của giới từ.

e.g: - The bus (that) I'm waiting for is late.

- Is this the article (which) you were interested in?
- That's the man (who) I was talking about.

-I can't remember the name of the hotel we stayed at.

3. Giới từ đứng đầu mệnh đề quan hệ

e.g: - Was that the restaurant to which you usually go?

- Electronics is a subject about which I know very little.

Trong tiếng Anh trang trọng, giới từ đứng đầu mệnh đề quan hệ, trước which hoặc whom.

Chúng ta không thể đặt giới từ trước that hoặc who.

e.g: a subject (that) I know little about

NOT: a subject-about that I know little the person (who) I got the figures from

NOT: the-person from who I got the figures
