The purpose becomes about helping the team or you can find purpose in your making progress. Now you need to find balance. First decide what things in life bring you pleasure and purpose. Then design your life so you do as many of them as possible. Some parts of our lives are the result of good or bad luck, but we can still design the parts that are under our control to maximize happiness.
