## **Passage**

The first things that I would like to include in "the living together" notion are the good relations with his family. This also involves sharing equally the housework.

Lots of people think that everyone should share the housework equally but in many homes, parents do most of it. To my mind, many families can't share the housework whereas they should try it. In fact, sharing the housework equally is not very possible because of the families' timetable. I believe that children and parents must do things together. For **this**, they can establish a housework planning.

In addition, housework's contributions of the teenager make him more responsible. He will think that he has an important role in his family. According to me, teenagers should share the housework because that will help them when they will have to found their own family in the future.

Too many teenagers and young adults leave home without knowing how to cook or clean, but if parents **delegate** basic housework to teens as they are older to do it, they won't be destabilized by doing the housework in their new grown-up life.

It can be possibly concluded that many parents don't really prepare their children for future, because they don't stimulate them to learn how to run a house. If parents get them responsible, teens will be more responsible and that will improve family's life.

### **Passage**

A recent study shows that an unequal share of household chores is still the norm in many households despite the fact that many more women now have jobs. In a survey of 1,256 people ages between 18 and 65, men said they contributed an average of 37% of the total housework, while the women estimated their share to be nearly double that, at 70%. This ratio was not affected by whether the woman was working or not.

When they were asked what they thought was a fair division of labour, women with jobs felt that housework should be shared equally between male and female partners. Women who did not work outside the home were satisfied to perform 80% - the majority of the household work - if their husbands did remainder. Research has shown that, if levels increase beyond these percentages, women become unhappy and anxious, and feel they are unimportant

After marriage, a woman is reported to increase her household workload by 14 hours per week, but for men the amount is just 90 minutes. So the division of labour becomes unbalanced, as a man's share increases much less than the woman's share.

It is the inequality and loss of respect, not the actual number of hours, which leads to anxiety and depression. The research describes housework as thankless and unfulfilling. Activities included in the study were cooking, cleaning, shopping, doing laundry, washing up and childcare. Women who have jobs report that they feel overworked by these chores in addition to their professional duties. In contrast, full-time homemakers frequently anticipate going back to work when the children grow up. Distress for this group is caused by losing the teamwork in the marriage.
