Sports have long been a favourite pastime, if not a fanatical obsession, for people from all walks of life. Not only do sports exist as a source of entertainment for the public, but also a lucrative business enterprise for those who provide financial backing.

Consider the following example. Major League Baseball consisted of only a handful of teams when the National League was founded in 1876. It has grown in popularity **by leaps and bounds** over the years, resulting in increased ticket sales for games and improving the profits of its investors. The increased demand from the public, in turn, forced the formation of a new division, known as the American League, in 1901. Also, new teams have been formed from time to time in accordance with regional demand; such was the case with the Colorado Rockies in Denver, Colorado, and the Rays in Tampa Bay, Florida.

However, the sport which has reaped the largest monetary investment has been American basketball. Successful marketing, together with the aggressive recruitment of new players, helped to keep Americans' interest in this sport. With hindsight, it appears that the National Basketball Association (NBA) received the most substantial boost commercially when several new teams were set up. Previously existing teams, such as the Chicago Bulls, also experienced an increase in popularity during that era.
