TOO ... TO... / ENOUGH TO.../ SO THAT.../ SUCH THAT ...

1/ TOO ... TO (*quá ... không thể*)

S + V(thường) + too + adv + (for + O) + to inf.

S + to be + too + adj + (for + O) + to inf.

+ Dùng “for + O” khi 2 chủ từ khác nhau.

- Ex:** - He is too young to drive a car.
- The house is too expensive for me to buy.
- He talked too fast for us to understand.

2/ ENOUGH ... TO

**S +
to be + adj
+ enough + (for + O) + to inf.
V(thường) + adv**

- Ex:** - It isn't warm enough for us to go out.
- He doesn't speak slowly enough for me to understand.

+ Dùng “for + O” khi 2 chủ từ khác nhau.

3/ SO ... THAT (*quá ... đến nỗi*)

**S + V(thường) + so + adv + that + Clause (mệnh đề)
(S + V + ...)
S + to be + so + adj + that + Clause**

- Ex:** - He walked so fast that I couldn't keep up with him.
- The book is so interesting that I can't put it down.

4/ SUCH ... THAT

a/

S + to be + such a / an + adj + N(đếm được số ít) + that + Clause

- Ex:** - It was such a boring film that I left before the end of it.
- He is such a good boy that everyone loves him.
- It is such an expensive book that I can't buy it.

b/

**S + V + such + adj + N
không đếm được
số nhiều
+ that + Clause**

- Ex:** - It was such good food that I ate a lot. (food là danh từ không đếm được)
- They are such interesting books that I've read them many times.

so many + dt số nhiều

so much + dt không đếm được

such a lot of + dt số nhiều/dt không đếm được

quá nhiều...

Ex:

- There are so many **people** there that it's impossible for us to get in.
- She added so much **salt** that the soup was too salty to eat.
- I drank such a lot of **coffee** that I couldn't sleep last night.
- They have such a lot of **books** that they need to store some of them in the garage.

so few + dt số nhiều

so little + dt không đếm được } ***quá ít***

- He had so few **friends** that he was very lonely.
- In intergalactic space, there's so little **energy** that atoms can't combine.

• **So + adjective + a/an + noun:**

The girl was so beautiful that he couldn't help staring open-mouthed.

She was **so beautiful a girl** that he couldn't help staring open-mouthed.

She was **such a beautiful girl** that he couldn't help staring open-mouthed.
