Without a healthy and sustainable environment, their own health and ability to leave behind a sustainable planet to those who live after them is negatively affected. Therefore, two main environmental benefits can be realised with greener living.

Firstly, people can <u>conserve</u> natural resources. The natural resources <u>that</u> man has been enjoying are beginning to disappear. Due to population growth, it is estimated that the use of natural resources has increased more than threefold since 1970.
