In modern football or soccer, yellow and red cards have become indispensable. However, you may be surprised to know that the carding system, whose creator was inspired by traffic lights, is actually a fairly recent concept in this sport.

The story of the cards began in the 1966 World Cup, when an English referee named Ken Aston was watching an extremely intense quarterfinal match between England and Argentina. During this match, the German referee Rudolf Kreitlein ordered Argentina's captain Antonio Rattin to leave the pitch for using offensive language. But Kreitlein did not speak Spanish, creating confusion and resulting in Rattin refusing to leave the pitch. This moment made Aston realise that there needs to be a change to combat this communication issue.
