Guidelines, and Regulations

About Ambassadors Scholarships:

The Inaugural edition of Ambassadors Scholarships through your High Commission in India at Rishihood University (RU) India is a prestigious International scholarship for students to both study and explore cross-culture in the world's largest democracy.

Up to 10 scholarships will be awarded for undergraduate studies to eligible individuals.

The scholarship will be categorized as follows:

- 1. 100% scholarship on tuition 2 students
- 2. 75% scholarship on tuition 2 students
- 3. 50% scholarship on tuition 3 students
- 4. 25% scholarship on tuition 3 students

The scholarships are for the whole duration of study subject to maintaining the academic performance as mentioned later in the details in this document.

The Scholarship selection committee will consist of officials from your High Commission in India and Rishihood University India.

Funded by the university, the Ambassadors Scholarships enable talented and motivated individuals to gain the knowledge and skills required for fostering positive change and are aimed at those who could not otherwise afford to study at RU, India.

Purpose:

To contribute to the development needs of developing countries by providing training for skilled and qualified professionals and academics, and to contribute to Indian higher education and foreign policy aims by encouraging collaboration and links.

Intended beneficiaries:

High-quality high school students who have the potential to enhance the development of their home country with the knowledge and leadership skills they acquire.

Eligibility:

To apply for these scholarships, you must:

- Be a citizen and permanent resident
- Be available to start your academic studies at Rishihood University India by the start of the Indian academic year in August 2024
- By July 2024, hold a relevant high school diploma for bachelor's program.
- Have provided all supporting documentation in the required format
- Not be able to afford to study at RU India without this scholarship

The Ambassador's scholarship aims to identify talented individuals who have the potential to make a change. We are committed to a policy of equal opportunity and non-discrimination and encourage applications from a diverse range of candidates.

How to apply:

You should apply to study at Rishihood University through the link https://apply.rishihood.edu.in/. You will be considered for the scholarship if you fulfill all the requirements.

All applications must be made online. The scholarship selection committee will not accept any applications that are not submitted via the online application system.

All applications must be submitted, and all mandatory fields completed in the application form by 17:00 (IST) on **31st July 2024**, at the latest.

You are advised to complete and submit your application as soon as possible, as the online application system will be very busy in the days leading up to the application deadline.



Your application must include the following supporting documentation by 17:00 (IST) on 31st July 2024 in order for your application to be eligible for consideration:

- Proof of citizenship: a copy of your valid passport (or national ID card) showing your photograph, date of birth, and country of citizenship – uploaded to the online application system
- Full transcripts detailing all your education qualifications including to-date transcripts for any qualifications you are currently studying – uploaded to the online application system.
- References may be asked from at least two individuals submitted directly by the referees to the online application system before the interview.

If any of these documents are not provided by the dates specified above, your application will be considered ineligible. It is your responsibility to ensure that your referees complete the references by the deadline and receive the reference requests.

The Ambassador's Scholarship Committee will not accept supporting documentation submitted by candidates outside the online application system.

Selection process:

The Embassy invites around three times more nominations than scholarships available for the interview – finally up to 10 candidates will be awarded a scholarship. There are no quotas for scholarships for any individual program.

Each nominated candidate's application will be considered in line with the Rishihood's Scholarships Selection Criteria, including by the Ambassador's selection committee in competition with other candidates.

Applications will be considered according to the following selection criteria:

- Academic merit of the candidate
- Quality of the plan of study
- Potential impact on the development of the candidate's home country

Tenure and placement:

- Awards are tenable at Rishihood University India with which your High Commission in India has signed Memorandum of Understanding for specific programs of study. Awards are to obtain one degree; funding will not be extended to enable candidates to complete a qualification in addition to or higher than that for which the selection was made.
- Awards are made in respect of full-time study only and no other course of study may be undertaken simultaneously.
- You must make clear in your application which qualification you are applying for. This will enable the committee to consider your application in the correct category. Applications that do not make this clear may be considered ineligible.

- You are advised to list the most preferred course that you think is the most appropriate for your study. This is important because the Committee will not change the course of a provisionally selected candidate after the point of selection unless exceptional information becomes available that could not have been foreseen at the time of application.
- The Scholarship selection committee will make the final decision on the program of study and reserves the right to overrule any preferences indicated by the candidate. The Committee will consider the suitability of the course and its value for money when deciding on any overrule.
- If you are not successful in getting a scholarship, then you can still study as a self-funded candidate.

Value:


Each scholarship provides:

- · Approved tuition fees
- If you declare a disability, a full assessment of your needs and eligibility for additional financial support may be offered by the committee.

NOTE: The scholarship holder has to cover hostel charges, his/her own flight, and visa charges. No monthly stipend will be provided.

General conditions:

- Ambassador's Scholarship covers approved tuition fees at Rishihood University. You should inform the scholarship committee if you are claiming any other scholarships, awards, or bursaries other than this.
- In order for the committee to administer your application effectively and
 efficiently after you have submitted it, it will be necessary to create a record
 in your name. If you are nominated for an award to the committee, your
 details will be kept on file. Basic anonymized demographic data for all
 applicants will be kept for analytical research. The committee is committed
 to protecting your personal information and to being transparent about the
 information we are collecting about you and what we do with it.
- If your application is successful, the committee will notify you via email that you have been provisionally selected (selected for an award subject to the committee agreeing to your terms of admission to the university)
- The Committee does not require any candidates to take an IELTS (English language) test. You should note, however, that, as a further condition of your scholarship, you may be required by your university to provide evidence of a particular level of English language proficiency including English tests.
- The Committee will not be able to offer you a scholarship if it would contravene the terms and conditions of another scholarship that you have previously held.
- When terms of admission to the university have been agreed upon, the Committee will send you a Notification of Award (formal offer of a scholarship).
- When all conditions of the Notification of Award have been met, the Committee will send you a formal Confirmation of Award.
- You will be required to submit a health and disability form before your Confirmation of Award can be issued in that category.



- You will be required to sign an undertaking to return to your home country as soon as possible after the end of your award.
- You are expected to start your award on the date stated in your Notification of Award.
- If you require a Student visa to come to India to study, you must meet all relevant immigration requirements set by Indian Visas and Immigration. You should check the official website for updated information.
- All Indian immigration regulations are set by Indian Visas and Immigration and are subject to change. The Committee has no control over these regulations.
- You will be selected for an award on the basis of the plan of study outlined on your application form, which is not expected to change significantly during your award. Any such changes must be agreed upon by the Committee.
- You are expected to reside in India throughout your award and to seek approval from the Committee in advance for any overseas travel.
- You must not undertake paid employment during your award without approval from the Committee in advance.
- The selected scholar must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 out of 4.0 for the scholarship continuation for the subsequent years of study.
- The Committee cannot provide a letter of support or permission for you to remain in or return to India after your award to enable you to work.
- Scholars will be expected to abide by the Commission's Code of Conduct for Award-Holders and Disciplinary Policy and Procedure. Your award may be terminated at any time for reasons of unsatisfactory conduct, progress, or attendance, or if your registration is suspended or terminated by your university for any reason.
- Applicants are expected to adhere to the Committee's Code of Conduct for award holders.
- The Committee is committed to administering and managing its scholarships and fellowships fairly and transparently.
