Mark Elliot Zuckerberg, an American businessman. He co-founded the social media service Facebook, (4)_____ his Harvard roommates in 2004, and its parent company Meta Platforms (formerly Facebook, Inc.), of which he is executive chairman, chief executive officer and controlling shareholder. Zuckerberg briefly attended Harvard University, (5)_____ he launched Facebook in February 2004 with his roommates Eduardo Saverin, Andrew McCollum, Dustin Moskovitz and Chris Hughes. Originally launched in only select college campuses, the site (6)_____ rapidly and eventually beyond colleges, reaching one billion users in 2012. Zuckerberg took the company public in May 2012 with majority shares. In 2007, at age 23, he was the world's youngest self-made (7)_____ at the time. Time named Zuckerberg one of the most influential people in the world in 2008, 2011, 2016 and 2019, and nominated him as a finalist several other times. He was named the Time Person of the Year in 2010, the same year when Facebook eclipsed more than half a billion users. In December 2016, Zuckerberg was ranked tenth on the Forbes list of the World's Most Powerful People. In the Forbes 400 list of (8)_____ Americans in 2023, he was ranked eighth with a personal wealth of \$106 billion. As of January 2024, Zuckerberg's net worth was estimated at \$135 billion by Forbes, making him the fifth richest person in the world.

Modern technology has been proved to have positive effects on mental health since it can provide a sense of community and social support. With the rise of social media and messaging apps, we can now communicate with families, friends and other people in real-time, regardless of where they are located. Additionally, technology has made it possible for medical professionals to access patient records and communicate with other healthcare providers, which has improved the quality of care for patients. However, the use of modern technology is obviously linked to a range of mental health issues, including anxiety, depression and sleep disorders, and the constant barrage of notifications and the pressure to stay connected can also lead us to feel overwhelmed and burned out. Therefore, we must work out some tips to balance the need for staying connected and the negative effects of excessive screen time.

To start with, higher use of social media makes people three times more likely to have perceived social isolation. According to recent research, 73% of heavy social media users report feeling lonely compared to 52% of light social media use, and 56% of people say that technology at work reduces their in-person interaction. Hence, decreasing time on social media can reduce feelings of loneliness for adults aged 18 to 22. Secondly, it is better to set boundaries for ourselves, which means establishing limits on screentime, particularly before bedtime, because the blue light range emitted from electronic gadgets can disrupt circadian rhythms and make it harder to sleep. In addition, we are advised to take regular breaks from technology to engage in physical activity or pursue any kinds of activities that can bring you joy and relaxation including meditation, yoga or simply taking a relaxing bath. Lastly, we must be mindful of our online habits. In other



words, we should try to avoid comparing ourselves to others on social media and limit our exposure to negative content; instead, it is necessary to focus on positive and uplifting content that supports your mental wellbeing.

As technology advances, it is essential to consider the potential impacts of new technological advancements and work to **mitigate** any negative effects. Ultimately, it is up to all of us to ensure that technology always benefits humanity and that we seek a balance between its benefits and the challenges **it** presents.
