 $Used\ to\ +\ Verb-bare\ infinitive$ 

Would + Verb – bare infinitive

- 1. Chúng ta sử dụng **used to** và **would** để nói về những thói quen và tình huống khác trong quá khứ. (His family **used to** be extremely poor. When he was young, he'**d** spend time studying medicine.)
- 2. Với động từ trạng thái, chúng ta **dùng used to**, không dùng would (*He used to love reading*. *He would love reading*.)
- 3. Chúng ta **tránh sử dụng would** với câu hỏi và câu phủ định. (*Did he use to play with cars and dolls?* Would he play with cars and dolls?)
- 4. Khi chúng ta nói một thói quen hoặc tình huống trong quá khứ kéo dài bao lâu, ta **dùng thì quá khứ đơn,** không dùng used to, would. (*He went to college for five years. He used to /would go to college for five years.*)
