The Asian Game, also called the Asiad, is a multi-sport event organized every four years among (5)\_\_\_\_\_ from over Asia. The Games are regulated by the Olympic Council of Asia (OAC) under the supervision of the International Olympic Committee (IOC). Medals are given in each event, with gold for first, silver for (6)\_\_\_\_\_ and bronze for third, a traditional principle which started in 1951. The Games are described as the second largest multi-sport event after the Olympic Games. In its history, nine nations have hosted the Asian Games. Forty-six nations have (7)\_\_\_\_\_ in the Games, including Israel, which was excluded from the Games after their last participation in 1974.
