The sea has been rising relative to the land for at least 100 years, geologists say. During that same period, the Atlantic Coast has eroded an average of two to three feet per year, the Gulf Cast even faster. Many engineers maintain

that seawalls and replenished beaches are necessary to protect the nation's shoreline.

The problem with seawalls is that **they** simply don't work. One study has shown that, in fact, seawalls make beaches erode faster.

Faced with the loss of their beaches, other communities have tried a solution: replace the lost sand. These replenishment programs, however, are costly and of dubious value. Another study has shown that only ten percent of replenished beaches lasted more than 5 years.
