According to a 2015 report conducted by Dr Greenfield, more than half of US adults check their smartphones every five to ten minutes, at least. “**This** could be a sign of addiction”, he said. He explains that as people use their devices more regularly, their brains will get used to using them. Therefore, when they can't use their devices, they feel panic and uneasy.

Dr Greenfield recommends a detox (not-use-device time) of at least three days for people who are addicted. But a detox can be as long as you choose. You can start with small steps. Turn off your device notifications, so beeps from text messages or apps won't **tempt** you to look at your phone. Then put your smartphone out of sight, so you won't be able to take a peek. Choose one time of day to check your messages.

There are also smartphone apps that can help. They keep track of your smartphone use and let you know when it's time for a break. There are even camps for adults where no digital devices are allowed.
