I/ <u>TYPE I</u>: <u>REAL CONDITION/ POSSIBLE CONDITION</u> (Đ/K có thật ở HT/ TL)

IT - Clause

Simple present (h. tại đơn)

Main clause

Simple future (T.Lai don) (will / shall + V- bare inf.)

ins we will stay at home

- <u>EX</u>: If it *rains*, we *will stay* at home.
 - I will go to the theatre tomorrow if it is nice.
 - You won't pass the exam if you don't try to study hard.

<u>Biến thể</u>:

<u>If - clause</u>	Main clause
1/ hiện tại đơn	h/tại đơn (sự thật, thói quen)
2/ hiện tại đơn	can / may/ must + V (bare-inf)
3/ h/tại đơn	mệnh lệnh $(V/ don't + V)$
4/ HTĐ / HTHT	TL đơn

- **<u>EX</u>**: I usually *have* a headache if I stay up late. (1)
 - If you are in a hurry you *can use* my car. (2)
 - If you meet Mary , *tell* her to phone me. (3)
 - I'll come back later if you *are working* now. (4)
 - I'll post the letter for you if you *have finished* it. (4)

UNLESS = IF - - - NOT

<u>EX 1</u>:

If she doesn't get up early, she will be late for class.

→ Unless she gets up early she will be late for class.

<u>EX 2</u>:

If the weather is clear tomorrow, we will go camping.

→Unless the weather is clear tomorrow, we won't go camping.

♦ OR/ OR ELSE/ OTHERWISE:

<u>EX 1</u>:

Study harder or you will fail the exam.

→ Unless you study harder, you will fail the exam.

<u>EX 2</u>:

You must water these plants regularly or they will die.

- →If you don't water these plants regularly, they will die.
- → Unless you water these plants regularly, they will die.

II/ <u>TYPE II</u>: <u>PRESENT UNREAL CONDITION</u> : (đ/k không có thật ở hiện tại/ T.Lai)

<u>lf – clause</u>	Main clause
Simple past	would
(quá khứ đơn)	could
(Past progressive) (QKTD)	might

EX: - If I were you , I would buy that car.

- I *could phone* Ann if I *knew* her number.

- If our uncle *weren't working* now, he *might help* us.

III/ <u>TYPE III</u>: <u>PAST UNREAL CONDITION</u>: (đ/k không có thật ở quá khứ)

<u>lf – clause</u>	<u>Main clause</u>
Past perfect (qkht)	would
(had + Ved/ V3)	could \downarrow + have + Ved/ V ₃
Past perfect progressive (QKHTTD) (had+ been+ V-ing)	might

EX: - If you had studied hard you wouldn't have failed the exam.
 - Would you have come to visit me if you had had free time?
 IV. Mixed Type: DK HON HOP

1/

<u>If – clause</u>	<u>Main clause</u>
Past perfect (qkht) (had + Ved/ V3)	would could might + V (bare inf.)

<u>EX</u>: If I hadn't stayed up late last night, I wouldn't be tired now.
2/

<u>If – clause</u>	Main clause
Simple Past (QKĐ)	would could might $+$ have + Ved/ V ₃

Ex: If I spoke Japanese, I could have translated her message yesterday.

₩ <u>ĐẢO NGỮ</u>:

1/Loai 1: Should + S + V (bare-inf) +...., S+ will/ can/ may + V (bare- inf)

Ex: If you see Tom, can you give him my message?
→ Should you see Tom, can you give him my message?
2/Loại 2:
Were + S +,
Were + S + to V(bare) +...., S + would/ could/ might + V (bare-inf)
Ex:
- If I were you, I would find another job.

→ Were I you, I would find another job.

3/Loại 3: Had + S + V_{3/ed} +, S + would/ could/ might + have + V_{3/ed}
 Ex: If Alan had asked me, I would have helped him.
 → Had Alan asked me, I would have helped him.

NOTE: Phủ định đặt "NOT" sau chủ từ

<u>Ex:</u> Were she <u>not</u> ill, she would help us.<u>Ex:</u> Had he <u>not</u> driven so fast, he wouldn't have had an accident.
