

UNLOCK LISTENING & SPEAKING SKILLS 2

FINAL TEST (SECOND SEMESTER)

Skill: Speaking **Time:** 1-1.5 minutes/ student

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This speaking test consists of ONE part, which takes around 1-1.5 minutes per student.

***Instruction:** The examiner invites TWO students each time according to the given student list at a time. Give each pair of students around 2 minutes to prepare and then ask them to present their conversation.*

***Note:** The two students are NOT allowed to discuss with each other during preparation. Student A will be the first one to start the conversation.*
